(**Time 1:00**) Finance Chair AB Rubin called the budget briefing to order. He then asked John Guilbeau to offer the invocation and Bryan Tabor to lead the Pledge of Allegiance.

Chair Rubin welcomed attendees to the Parish Wrap-Up budget review, noting procedures for public comment, seating arrangements, and decorum (no food/drink; devices silenced). Public comments limited to departmental budgets; other matters should be directed to the Administration. Budget posted online at <a href="www.LafayetteLA.gov">www.LafayetteLA.gov</a>. Council may take one of two actions: general amendment or a separate amendment. Amendments tied to specific districts will generally be offered by that district's Councilmember; general amendments by the Chair. Chair Rubin announced that Donald Richard would be unable to attend today's briefing.

Chair Rubin withdrew Separate Amendment #1 and Separate Amendment #2.

## **NEW FINANCE "HOUSEKEEPING" AMENDMENTS:**

Chair Rubin recognized CFO Karen Fontenot for an overview of additional amendments for consideration that have been compiled by Finance.

Guilbeau offered Lafayette Parish Sheriff Mark Garber time to speak for his department in lieu of the recently withdrawn Separate Amendments 1 & 2. Warden Benoit and Touchet, introduced by Sheriff Garber, gave a brief overview of current jail operations and Lafayette Parish Sheriff's Office (LPSO) finances, particularly as they relate to the current and proposed jails.

### **GENERAL AMENDMENTS:**

Chair Rubin requested that Councilmembers review the General Amendments and indicate whether they would

like to make any changes, which were made as follows

- \*\*GENERAL AMENDMENT BY TABOR To provide capital appropriation to Adult Correction in the amount of \$1 million from the Courthouse Complex Fund in order to balance Fund 2620 as a result of the City's elimination of appropriation to Correctional Center\*\*
- \*\*<u>GENERAL AMENDMENT BY RUBIN</u> To increase Jailer Services Overflow by \$500,000 and adding external appropriation for LPSO maintenance salaries; 08-28-2025 Amendment #S, as provided by Finance\*\*

## **SEPARATE AMENDMENTS:**

Chair Rubin requested that Councilmembers review the Separate Amendments and indicate whether they would like to make any changes, which were made as follows:

• Separate Amendments #1 and #2 were withdrawn earlier in the meeting.

### **WRAP-UP ITEMS:**
