BUDGET BRIEFING – PARISH THURSDAY, AUGUST 29, 2024; 1:00 P.M. 705 W. University Avenue, Council Auditorium Wrap-Up

(**Time 1:11**) Finance Chair Ken Stansbury called the budget briefing to order. He then asked John Guilbeau to offer the invocation and AB Rubin to lead the Pledge of Allegiance.

Chair Stansbury welcomed everyone to this budget briefing on the proposed Fiscal Year (FY) 2024-2025 budget. Citizens were instructed that a speaker form should be filled out in order to address the Council and be submitted to Council Clerk Veronica L. Arceneaux. He stated that the proposed budget document has been posted to the LCG website on the Finance page and that public comment would be held immediately following each department's budget review. Chair Stansbury identified the two (2) possible actions that could be taken during the Wrap-Up briefing. A Council member may propose changing the budget by: (1) a general amendment, when the entire Council agrees on a recommendation/proposed amendment or (2) a separate amendment, when a Council member objects to a recommended budget change. Chair Stansbury announced that Bryan Tabor would be unable to attend today's briefing.

NEW FINANCE "HOUSEKEEPING" AMENDMENTS:

Chair Stansbury recognized CFO Karen Fontenot for an overview of additional amendments for consideration that have been compiled by Finance, which were made as follows:

- **GENERAL AMENDMENT BY STANSBURY To adjust vehicle capital items in Public Works rom purchase to lease, 8/29/2024 Amendment #34 (Parish), as provided by Finance**
- **GENERAL AMENDMENT BY GUILBEAU To adjust vehicle capital items in Traffic, Roads & Bridges from purchase to lease, 8/29/2024 Amendment #35 (Parish), as provided by Finance**
- **GENERAL AMENDMENT BY RUBIN To fund increase in transportation/housing charges for JDH as required by state mandate, 8/29/2024 Amendment #36 (Parish), as provided by Finance**
- **SEPARATE AMENDMENT BY GUILBEAU 10% salary increase for five Parish Council

Members for current term, 8/29/2024 Amendment #37 (Parish), as provided by Finance. Rubin originally offered this as a general amendment.**

City-Parish Attorney Pat Ottinger offered an explanation on the Home Rule Charter provision for invoking the 10% salary increase for Council members. Clerk of the Council Veronica Arceneaux added that the option would be given for Council members to decline acceptance of their individual increases.

Chair Stansbury requested that Council members review General Amendments and indicate whether they would like to make any changes, which were made as follows:

• Rubin withdrew <u>Separate Amendment #1</u> – 10% salary increase for Parish Councilman AB Rubin for the current term.
