## Summary of Substantial Amendments to the LCG 2021 HOME-ARP Action Plan

---

On January 10, 2024, the Lafayette Consolidated Government (LCG), Community Development and Planning Department (CDP) held Public Hearing #1 to develop the 2024 Annual Action Plan. At this hearing, LCG-CDP also provided an update to the HOME-ARP funding allocation of \$2,251,381 made to Lafayette by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). LCG-CDP defined the Qualifying Population (QP) and eligible uses of HOME-ARP funds at this hearing, and the public was invited to submit applications to be funded by HOME-ARP.

On April 10, 2024, LCG-CDP held Public Hearing #2 to develop the 2024 Annual Action Plan. At this hearing, LCG-CDP proposed funding the non-profit organization's activities for HOME-ARP funding, which are detailed below.

CDP is proposing to fund the following activities as part of its 2021 HOME-ARP Action Plan Amendment:

- **Catholic Charities of Acadiana – Supportive Services** – Catholic Charities of Acadiana will receive an additional \$250,000 in HOME-ARP funds in the Supportive Services category to cover the costs of Case Managers' salaries that assist QP persons in finding stable housing. The award will total \$540,000.
