## Summary of Substantial Amendments to the LCG 2021 HOME-ARP Action Plan

---

On January 13, 2026, the Lafayette Consolidated Government (LCG), Community Development and Planning Department (CDP) held Public Hearing #1 to develop the 2026 Annual Action Plan. At this hearing, LCG-CDP also provided an update to the HOME-ARP funding allocation of \$2,254,750 made to Lafayette by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). LCG-CDP defined the Qualifying Population (QP) and eligible uses of HOME-ARP funds at this hearing, and the public was invited to submit applications to be funded by HOME-ARP.

On April 2, 2026, LCG-CDP held Public Hearing #2 to develop the 2026 Annual Action Plan. At this hearing, LCG-CDP proposed funding the non-profit organization's activities for HOME-ARP funding, which are detailed below.

CDP is proposing to fund the following activities as part of its 2021 HOME-ARP Action Plan Amendment:

- **Faith House, Inc. – Supportive Services at Domestic Violence Shelter** – Faith House assists survivors of domestic violence through its emergency and transitional facilities. LCG will provide \$122,648 in HOME-ARP funds for supportive services to cover the costs of Case Management salaries & benefits, transportation costs, office supplies, utilities, and insurance in support of its domestic violence survivors' program.
- **Faith House, Inc. – Non-Profit Operating Costs** – Faith House will receive \$41,947 in HOME-ARP funds for Non-Profit Operating Costs to support its domestic violence survivors' supportive services program.
