ORDINANCE NO. JO-069-2024

A JOINT ORDINANCE OF THE LAFAYETTE CITY COUNCIL AND THE LAFAYETTE PARISH COUNCIL AMENDING THE LAFAYETTE CITY-PARISH CONSOLIDATED GOVERNMENT CODE OF ORDINANCES CHAPTER 2 "ADMINISTRATION" BY CREATING AND ENACTING ARTICLE VI THEREIN RELATIVE TO PUBLIC RECORD REQUESTS AND THE FEE SCHEDULE FOR THE PRODUCTION AND/OR TRANSMISSION OF COPIES OF PUBLIC RECORDS IN RESPONSE TO PUBLIC RECORD REQUESTS

BE IT ORDAINED by the Lafayette City Council and the Lafayette Parish Council, that:

WHEREAS, article XII, Section 3 of the Louisiana Constitution of 1974 provides that "no person shall be denied the right to observe the deliberations of public bodies and examine public documents, except in cases established by law;" and

WHEREAS, the Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government is committed to transparency and providing every person with open, convenient and low-cost access to public records as required by the Louisiana Constitution and the Louisiana Public Records Law (La. R.S. 44:1 et seq.); and

WHEREAS, under the Louisiana Public Records Law, any person 18 years or older may request inspection, reproduction, and copying of a public record; and

WHEREAS, La. R.S. 44:32C(1)(a) provides that it shall be the duty of the custodian of such public records to provide copies to persons so requesting, and the custodian may establish and collect reasonable fees for making copies of public records, which may include the transmission of electronic copies of public records; and

WHEREAS, La. R.S. 44:32C(1)(a) further provides that "any custodian who elects to establish and collect fees shall establish a reasonable fee schedule and post the schedule where it can be readily accessed by the public," and that said fees may be collected in advance of production; and

WHEREAS, Sect. 2-11(A)(3) of the Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government Home Rule Charter provides that an ordinance is necessary to impose a charge; and

WHEREAS, the Lafayette City Council and the Lafayette Parish Council desire to amend the Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government Code of Ordinances, Chapter 2 "Administration" by creating and enacting Article VI relative to public record requests and the fee schedule for the production and/or transmission of copies of public records in response to the public record requests.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED by the Lafayette City Council and the Lafayette Parish Council, that:

SECTION 1: All of the aforedescribed "Whereas" clauses are adopted as part of this ordinance.

SECTION 2: Chapter 2, Article VI of the Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government Code of Ordinances is hereby created and enacted to read, as follows:

ARTICLE VI. PUBLIC RECORD REQUESTS

Sec. 2-180. Fee Schedule.

The fee charges for copies and/or electronic transmission of records in response to public record requests shall be as follows:





La. R.S. 44:32C(1)(a) provides that it shall be the duty of the custodian of such public records to provide copies to persons so requesting, and the custodian may establish and collect reasonable fees for making copies of public records, which may include the transmission of electronic copies of public records. La. R.S. 44:32C(1)(a) further provides that "any custodian who elects to establish and collect fees shall establish a reasonable fee schedule and post the schedule where it can be readily accessed by the public," and that said fees may be collected in advance of production.

After considering the fee charges of other similarly situated political subdivisions, such as, Baton Rouge, Lake Charles, New Orleans, Shreveport, and Alexandria as well as the State of Louisiana, the proposed fee charges fall within the median of fee charges considered. The proposed fee schedule is in line with what is being charged by Lake Charles and New Orleans for public record requests, with Shreveport and Alexandria falling in the lower range and Baton Rouge falling in the higher range.





This is a Joint Ordinance as it pertains to amending the Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government Code of Ordinances and creating and establishing the fee schedule for public record requests for records of the Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government.
