PARC is now accepting applications for seasonal summer positions across recreation centers, camps, and aquatic facilities.

Camp Director

Job Description: Responsible for overall camp leadership and operations, including staff supervision, risk prevention, and camper well-being.

Key Duties: Oversee staff performance, track attendance and timeliness, manage camper allergies and accommodations, develop weekly programming, and ensure safety compliance.

Skills/Requirements: Strong leadership, organization, and problem-solving skills. Youth programming experience required. CPR/First Aid preferred.

Assistant Camp Director

Job Description: Supports Camp Director with daily operations, scheduling, and field trip logistics.

Key Duties: Coordinate transportation, assist with activity planning, communicate updates to staff, and help manage behavior and scheduling issues.

Skills/Requirements: Strong communication and multitasking skills. Prior leadership or camp experience preferred.

Camp Counselor

Job Description: Supervise and engage campers in daily activities while maintaining a safe and positive environment.

Key Duties: Lead games, crafts, learning sessions, assist with meals and transitions, and monitor safety during field trips.

Skills/Requirements: Energetic, dependable, team-oriented, and good with children. Experience a plus.

Camp Administrative Assistant

Job Description: Provides administrative and communication support for camp operations.

Key Duties: Manage registration and check-in/out, maintain camper records, update web content, respond to parent inquiries, and distribute information.

Skills/Requirements: Organized, detail-oriented, and proficient in basic office and web tools.

Lifeguard

Job Description: Ensures the safety of patrons at PARC aquatic facilities.

Key Duties: Monitor pools, enforce safety rules, respond to emergencies, conduct water rescues, and assist with swim programming as needed.

Skills/Requirements: Current lifeguard certification, CPR/First Aid, strong swimming ability, and alertness.

Aquatic / Pool Manager

Job Description: Oversees daily operations of aquatic facilities and supervises lifeguard staff.

Key Duties: Schedule staff, ensure safety compliance, manage pool operations, handle incidents, and support programming.

Skills/Requirements: Leadership experience, lifeguard certification, strong communication and organizational skills.

Recreation Center & Athletic Coordinators (Seasonal)

Job Description: Support summer programming and/or Athletic Programming at recreation centers and/or outdoor fields including sports, enrichment activities, and special events.

Key Duties: Assist instructors, supervise participants, set up activities, and maintain safe environments.

Skills/Requirements: Dependable, positive attitude, and interest in youth or community programming.

Seasonal Custodian / Janitor

Job Description: Provides cleaning and sanitation support across recreation centers, camps, and aquatic facilities during peak summer operations.

Key Duties: Clean restrooms and common areas, empty trash, disinfect high-touch surfaces, assist with event and program setup/cleanup, and maintain safe, presentable facilities.

Skills/Requirements: Dependable, able to perform physical tasks, attention to cleanliness and safety standards. Prior custodial experience preferred but not required.
