In compliance with the Louisiana Pollution Discharge Elimination System (LPDES) permit as well as Lafayette Consolidated Government Code of Ordinances Chapter 34, Article V, any person applying for a permit for a project involving the disturbance of <u>one to five acres</u>, or that is part of a development involving the disturbance of one to five acres shall submit:

(a) A site specific Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP)

Any person applying for a permit for a project involving the disturbance of <u>five acres or more</u>, or that is part of a development involving the disturbance of five acres of more, shall submit:

- (a) A site specific Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP), and
- (b) A Notice of Intent (NOI) to the Louisiana Department of Environmental Quality (LDEQ) for an LPDES permit for the site.

Public Works personnel will review the SWPPP and NOI if required. Your application approval for the permit may be delayed until the SWPPP and NOI are approved by PW personnel.
