No one should have to wait in the rain.

Lafayette has more than 500 bus stops—but **fewer than 10% of all stops are covered**. That means thousands of riders wait in the rain, scorching sun, or cold each year. You can help change that.

Adopt-A-Stop is a public-private partnership launched in 2018 by City Councilwoman Liz Hebert, in collaboration with Community Foundation of Acadiana and Lafayette Consolidated Government. Your tax-deductible donation helps fund new covered bus stops that provide safety, dignity, and shelter for public transit users.
